The entire house was a gut rehab. Two structural beams were added to accommodate an oversized Ann-Morris pot rack in the center of the room. The English scullery kitchen design was inspired by British designer Christopher Peacock. One wall is cabinetry, made by Plato Woodwork of Plato, Minn. The Viking 10-burner stove is backed by marble subway tiles. The bespoke hardware protecting the wood corners of the walnut butcher block was produced by Wilmette Hardware, Ill. The breakfast nook features a banquette bench made in Chicago and covered in a Holly Hunt leather, and a classic Saarinen Tulip table.
